Supply List

Material for bodice, skirt, and slip (cotton), small scrap of contrasting material for bow.

Velcro

Card stock

Staining: Instant coffee, vanilla extract, fragrance oil. Optional for staining: Old cookie sheet, rags, wax paper, glass jar with lid.

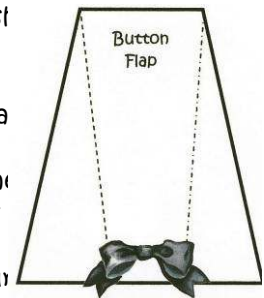
Annie Dress Hand Towel

Read through all directions before beginning.

Instructions:

1. Print out bodice pattern and trace on double material. Pin and cut out.
2. A plain sheet of card stock will be your pattern for the skirt (towel) and slip. Place this on double cotton material (or material of your chose) being sure to place on fold where indicated on illustration; trace and cut out (2); do the same with your white cotton material for the slip.
3. Okay so now you have cut out 2 bodice, 2 skirts, and 2 slips. Layering one skirt and one slip, sew a row of a gathering stitch about 1/4 inch from the top being sure to leave enough thread at both ends to enable you to "pull" to gather; do the same with the remaining skirt and slip. Pull to gather.
4. Pull to gather so that the width now matches the width of the bottom of the bodice. Match these up wrong sides together and sew the seams (do not sew the skirt (towel) together). Clip curves and turn.
5. Measure up 1 inch from bottom hem of skirt and tear off so that the slip will sit both sides.
6. Stain with directions given below. When completely dry; press.
7. Bow; with your scrap of contrasting material, tear a strip 1 inch x 15 inches; stain directions given below. When completely dry; press.
8. Fold the bodice down to the top of the skirt (see picture), place a small mark h the underside of the bodice, as this is where you will hand sew your small squares your Velcro by about 1/2 inch x 1/2 inch and sew Velcro squares on.
9. Fashion your "bow" into a bow and either glue or stitch on to bodice (see picture)

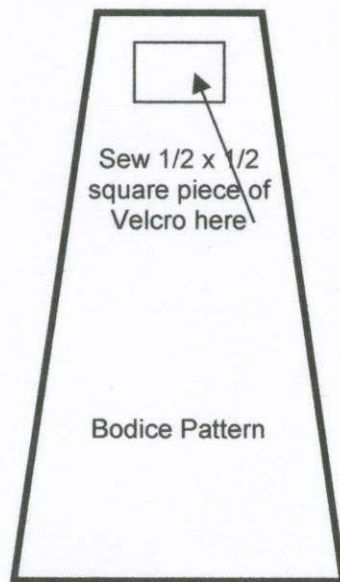


Staining: Combine 1/4 cup instant coffee, 2 cups hot water, 1/4 cup Vanilla extract and 1/4 teaspoon fragrance oil (Some of my preferred scents are Cinnamon bun, sugar cookies, and vanilla) in a glass jar with lid. Shake for few minutes until thoroughly mixed. If the scent is not strong enough for your preference, add another 1/8 teaspoon of fragrance oil and continue this until the scent is to your liking. However, I would suggest only adding 1/8 teaspoon of fragrance oil each time because if you add too much and the scent is too strong for you, you will have to start over. Line an old cookie sheet with old rags and lay what you're staining here. With a sponge brush or spray bottle thoroughly coat. Bake for 10 minutes at 250 degrees. Check often as this can catch on fire. If you have to bake longer, only bake at 5 minute increments and always KEEP checking the oven. Store left over stain mixture in glass jar with lid for your next primitive project.

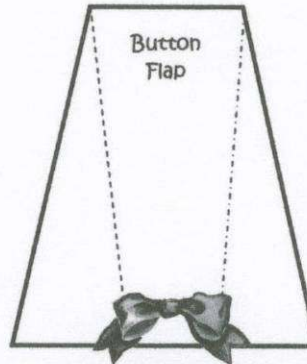

Fold Top Down
as in illustration below and
either sew or glue bow on
where indicated on
illustration below and in
picture on cover.



Sew a gathering stitch at top of skirt and
slip patterns. Leave enough thread at
both ends so you can pull to gather.
Pull to gather until the width is about the
same width as the bottom part of the
bodice as this is where it will be sewn on.
Make sure you have wrong sides
matching.
